**PVM Summer Splash 2010 provides flexible four (2-week) sessions as follows:**

- Session 1:** Monday, June 28<sup>th</sup> thru Friday, July 09<sup>th</sup>  
**Session 2:** Monday, July 12<sup>th</sup> thru Friday, July 23<sup>rd</sup>  
**Session 3:** Monday, July 26<sup>th</sup> thru Friday, August 06<sup>th</sup>  
**Session 4:** Monday, August 09<sup>th</sup> thru Friday, August 20<sup>th</sup>

**Registration:** Registration is per session. You may choose to register your child for some or all the sessions. Please indicate your choice of enrollment in the application form.

**Tuition:** Summer tuition includes many additional activities and field trips to make the summer program fun-filled and exciting. This tuition is only valid for the summer programs. Starting Fall 2010, the tuition rates go back to the regular academic schedule. Optional enrichment programs like Kindermusik, Spanish, Art, and Fun-Bus lessons will be for an additional fee.

**Field Trips:** Field trips to various museums and farms are planned for children ages three and above. Parents must fill out a permission form for their children to attend field trips. There will be various field-trip visits to the school by librarians, story tellers, puppeteers, magicians, nutritionist, musician, art and craft work, a petting zoo, hay rides, fire department, police department, health and safety, etc.

**Spanish Lessons:** Our Spanish lessons will continue during summer, taught by a special language instructor, as an optional class for children 3 and above. We encourage all parents to enroll their children for Spanish lessons. A second language has special benefits for the child in their sensory motor and language development skills.

**Fun-Bus:** Fun-Bus will continue during summer, providing gymnastic and physical exercise opportunities for the children.

**Kindermusik:** Kindermusik lessons will continue during summer, taught by a special music instructor.

**Art Lessons:** Art lessons will be provided during summer sessions, taught by a special art instructor, as an optional class for children 3 and above.

**Book Mobile:** Aurora Public Library's mobile library van will stop by the school once every week. Children will be able to checkout books and use them in the school. There will be story-telling time by the librarian as well. Kids will learn about the library, its procedures and rules.
